

How To Make A Bequest To The Skin Hospital

Leaving a bequest is simple and easy to do. To make a bequest, you will need to have a Will. If you have already have a Will, all you need to do is add a Codicil, which is an additional document used to make a minor change, amendment or alteration to an existing Will.

If you don't have a Will, we highly recommend you go to your solicitor or see the NSW State Trustee, who will be able to prepare one for you.

The Wording To Use

The following is the suggested wording to give to your solicitor to put in the Codicil or new Will, if you are writing your Will for the first time.

"I _______ give and bequeath the percentage/residue/specific sum or gift of property (insert your selection), free from all federal and state duties, to Skin & Cancer Foundation Australia (T/A The Skin Hospital) to be used for the general purposes of the organisation, with the written acknowledgement of Skin & Cancer Foundation Australia to be accepted by my executor/s or Trustee as an absolute discharge".
